INTRODUCTION

Racing ProdigyTM and Street Kart Racing, and all Racing Prodigy partners are excited to partner on an official Street Kart Racing six-round mobile simulation esports competition. This competition is limited to Street Kart Racing users who have registered on www.RacingProdigy.com.

This document is a guide for those wishing to compete in the Prodigy Racing League esports competition and should be read in addition to the other Racing Prodigy and Street Kart Racing rules applicable to all members.

This guide, together with <u>Street Kart Racing's Terms of Service & EULA</u>, <u>Street Kart Racing's Privacy Policy</u>, <u>Racing Prodigy's Sporting Code</u>, and <u>Racing Prodigy's Privacy Policy</u> form the body of rules and procedures applicable to the Street Kart Racing and Racing Prodigy members who compete in this competition (collectively, the "Rules").

Each member who intends to compete in this competition is required to read, understand, and agree to all Rules prior to participation. The Rules are a contract between each Street Kart Racing player, Fat Cigar Productions Ltd., Racing Prodigy member, and Racing Prodigy, Inc. When registering for the competition, Street Kart Racing and Racing Prodigy members may accept the Rules by accepting the click-through terms in the Street Kart Racing iOS game application and RacingProdigy.com. All information in this document is subject to change.

This competition – The Racing Prodigy SK Racing Season 2 Golden Ticket Series is a Racing Prodigy, Inc. competition and promotion. Physical prizes are funded and provided by Racing Prodigy, Inc. In-game digital prizes are funded and provided by Fat Cigar Productions Ltd. Street Kart Racing is a licensed partner of Racing Prodigy, Inc. and is providing the platform on which this online competition is taking place.





RACING PRODIGY OVERVIEW

Racing Prodigy has opened motorsports to all.

Historically, the cost of pursuing a career in motorsports has been so daunting that 99%+ of people never realize the opportunity or even dare dream of becoming a professional racer.

How did we change this?

It starts with sim racing. Millions compete, and we know, firsthand, sim racing skills transfer to the real race cars on real racetracks. This is why we partnered with game publishers, offering esports competitions across many sim racing games, enabling us to identify prodigies that may otherwise go undiscovered. These sim racers, many of whom will prove they can be the world's best in real-life (IRL) racers, will have the opportunity to earn one of many Prodigy PassesTM – the golden tickets of motorsports - to then compete in real race cars at Prodigy WeekTM.

<u>Prodigy Week, Season 1, Part 2</u>, was held at Atlanta Motorsports Park, one hour drive north of Atlanta, Georgia, May 13-15 – 20 Prodigy Pass winners competed in Radical SR1s, in the fitness center, skid pad, and autocross course with the major focus on track in the Radical SR1.

Following Prodigy Week, the inaugural Prodigy DraftTM saw 24 drivers selected by six Prodigy Racing Teams <u>live</u> <u>from the Williams Racing Fan Zone in downtown London</u>. These 24 drivers receive paid pro contracts to race in the Prodigy Three Championship, the first of three tiers of real-world racing in the PRL, starting November 16-17 at NOLA Motorsports Park.

These paid P3 drivers will fill the grid and compete for significant prize money in the first racing series made up of those who earned their way in—rather than bought their way in. (One cannot buy a drive in this series.) For those who excel on track in our P3 real-world series, there is the opportunity to move up to the second tier of real-world racing in 2025, also operated and controlled by Racing Prodigy. The goal is to establish three tiers of real racing, completing our e2RealTM league. For those with the skill, you should be able to build a career in motorsports with us, without the need to hunt for your own sponsors to stay in the sport.

This is why we have created the Prodigy Racing League - the world's first e2Real sports league. This league is the first in motorsports with a real-world ladder, open to all, regardless of bank account size or connections.

To continue to grow a new motorsport, we the e2Real league need support from the sim racing community via esports participation and social following and from partners who desire to transform motorsport. For 2024, more companies are joining us in our work to open motorsports to those with the skill. Thank you to Asetek_SimSports®, MPI, PitFit Training, SIM-LAB, GRID Engineering, and Racers Physio who helped kick-off the PRL. We added additional partners in PRL Season 1 Part 2, Mazda, SuckerPunch, Women in Motorsports North America, Toyo Tires, and Advanced SimRacing to our family and recently added Williams Esports, Thibaut Courtois, G2 Esports, and Guild Esports as Prodigy Racing Teams. We have launched an Open coaching marketplace on RacingProdigy.com to generate more support for the racers and revenue to fund the league. We are not handpicking sim racers to offer their coaching services; we are creating an open marketplace and ecosystem that allows those with the skill and effort to participate and flourish. With these efforts and more, we work to greatly expand the sport we love.

The only way we accomplish this is together.





ESPORTS COMPETITION INFORMATION

Eligibility

No purchase necessary to participate.

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a Street Kart Racing and Racing Prodigy member in good standing to compete in the competition.
- Be at least 13 years old by the final day of qualifying to compete and can provide legal proof.
- Have either a valid, unrestricted driver's license (learner's permit does not qualify) or a valid racing license from an accredited racing sanctioning body such as National Auto Sport Association, SportsCar Club of America, and others.
 - o **NOTE**: if you are Prodigy Pass winner and are not of the legal age for a driver's license, we will make our best and most reasonable efforts to help you obtain a racing license.
- Please reach out to Racing Prodigy prior to entering, if uncertain of rules, at support@RacingProdigy.com.

You are **ineligible** to compete in a Racing Prodigy competition if you:

- Are currently a legal resident in North Korea, Cuba, Iran, Syria, Myanmar, Crimea, Sudan, or Alaska.
- Under 13 years old by the end of the series.
- Have any professional racing experience in real life within sports car, stock car, or open wheel racing series such as, but not limited to: SRO, IMSA, IndyCar, Formula One, Formula 2, Formula 3, Indy Lights, Pro Mazda, USF2000, NASCAR Cup Series, Xfinity Series, NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series, and ARCA Menards Series. Exceptions are any sim-to-real scholarship winners (e.g., Nissan PlayStation GT Academy, World's Fastest Gamer) who have not competed in at least six (6) professional races dating back to January 1, 2023. **NOTE**: U.S. Legends Tour drivers are eligible.
- Are taller than 6'3" (190.5cm) in height and/or weigh more than 230 pounds (104kg) without driver gear or can't physically pilot the Radical SR1 race car without modifications to the car. These thresholds are to ensure driver safety in the Radical SR1.
- Racing Prodigy, Inc. employees, advisors, contractors, and their immediate family members (including spouse, children, parents, siblings, and any other persons residing in the same household) are not eligible to participate in the tournament or claim any prizes. This exclusion applies to individuals who are employed or associated with the organizing committee, sponsors, or any other entity directly involved in the planning, execution, or promotion of the tournament. The intention behind this restriction is to ensure fairness and impartiality in the competition, avoiding any potential conflicts of interest or favoritism.

Daily Qualifier Details

- All drivers will be driving on the same track conditions on a day-to-day basis. The weather will change from day to day but will remain constant throughout each given day, providing all competitors with an equal opportunity regardless of the time of day they compete.
- Drivers will be able to unlock up to six different Racing Prodigy X30 karts by qualifying in each monthly round.
- Tire wear will be set to ON. Stage 1 drivers will receive a set of Racing Prodigy Qualifying tires every 4
 hours for free. Stage 2 drivers will receive one set of Racing Prodigy tires per day. Tire Packs will be
 available for purchase.
- Spare Racing Prodigy Tires (from purchase) will be usable for any potential future Racing Prodigy SK Racing tournaments.
- Tires for the entire event will be the Racing Prodigy tires only. These have been designed specifically for the competition. Other tire brands will not be allowed.
- Tire, Kart, and Engine wear will be set to ON.
- Fuel will be consumed.
- You are not limited in the number of runs you turn in during the Pre-Qualifiers or Qualifers.
- The fastest times will be dynamically ranked in the leaderboards (changing in real time).
- iOS users with Push Notifications turned ON for Street Kart Racing will receive notifications on position changes. Message and data rates may apply.
- Premium Racing Prodigy X30 track karts will be available for purchase, providing direct access to the round's Silver Ticket Final. Users who purchase do not need to pre-qualify or qualify. The premium Racing Prodigy X30 Karts can also be used for all SK Racing events.

Silver Ticket Finals Details

- All drivers will be driving with the same track conditions, which will not change throughout the session.
- The Racing Prodigy X30 karts will be used for the Silver Ticket Finals.
- Tires will be the Racing Prodigy tires only, which have been designed specifically for the competition. Other tire brands will not be allowed.
- Tire wear will be set to ON. Stage 3 drivers will receive one set of Racing Prodigy soft and medium tires per day. Tire Packs will be available for purchase.
- Fuel will be consumed.
- You are not limited in the number of runs you turn in during the Silver Ticket Finals.
- The fastest times will be dynamically ranked in the leaderboards and will change dynamically as new times are created.
- iOS users with Push Notifications turned ON for Street Kart Racing will receive notifications on position changes. Message and data rates may apply.

Additional Season Competitions Awarding Prodigy Passes

SERIES CHAMPION - ONE (1) PRODIGY PASS

The driver who scores the most points across any three (3) rounds of the six (6) total rounds will be awarded with a Prodigy Pass (does not need to compete in the April Golden Ticket Finals).





MYSTERY EVENT - TWO (2) PRODIGY PASSES

To be announced in early 2025, this mystery event will award a Prodigy Pass to one of the top 50 female and top 50 overall drivers who compete in this event, selected by the Prodigy Search Committee – giving two more opportunities to those who show rising promise and talent.
