INTRODUCTION

Racing Prodigy[™] and Street Kart Racing are excited to partner on the second Prodigy Racing League[™] mobile simulation competition. This competition is limited to Street Kart Racing users who have registered on RacingProdigy.com.

This document is a guide for those wishing to compete in the Prodigy Racing League esports competition and should be read in addition to the other Racing Prodigy and Street Kart Racing rules applicable to all members.

This guide, together with <u>Street Kart Racing's Terms of Service & EULA</u>, <u>Street Kart Racing's Privacy Policy</u>, <u>Racing Prodigy's Sporting Code</u>, and <u>Racing Prodigy's Privacy Policy</u> form the body of rules and procedures applicable to the Street Kart Racing and Racing Prodigy members who compete in this competition (collectively, the "Rules").

Each member who intends to compete in this competition is required to read, understand and agree to all Rules prior to participation. The Rules are a contract between each Street Kart Racing player, Fat Cigar Productions Ltd., Racing Prodigy member, and Racing Prodigy, Inc. When registering for the competition, Street Kart Racing and Racing Prodigy members may accept the Rules by accepting the click-through terms in the Street Kart Racing iOS game application and RacingProdigy.com. All information in this document is subject to change.

The Prodigy Racing League SK Racing TKM Continental Cup is a Racing Prodigy, Inc. competition and promotion. Physical prizes are funded and provided by Racing Prodigy, Inc. In-game digital prizes are funded and provided by Fat Cigar Productions Ltd. Street Kart Racing is a licensed partner of Racing Prodigy, Inc. and is providing the platform on which this online competition is taking place.





RACING PRODIGY OVERVIEW

Racing Prodigy has set out to open motorsports to all.

Historically, the cost of pursuing a career in motorsports has been so daunting that 99%+ of people never realize the opportunity or even dare dream of becoming a professional racer.

How can we change this?

It starts with sim racing. Millions compete, and we know, firsthand, sim racing skills transfer to the real race cars on real racetracks. This is why we partnered with game publishers, offering esports competitions across many sim racing games, enabling us to identify prodigies that may otherwise go undiscovered. These sim racers, many of whom will prove they can be the world's best in real-life (IRL) racers, will have the opportunity to earn one of many Prodigy PassesTM – the golden tickets of motorsports - to then compete in real race cars at Prodigy WeekTM.

Prodigy Week, part 1, will be held at Atlanta Motorsports Park, one hour drive north of Atlanta, Georgia, October 30 – November 1, with the plan for the Pass winners to compete in Radical SR1s, and briefly in the fitness center, skid pad, autocross course, and sims. Focus is the Radical SR1. After this three-day event at the racetrack, Racing Prodigy plans to add more Prodigy Passes leading to Prodigy Week, part 2, in April 2024, also at Atlanta Motorsports Park.

The plan is then to draft racers from Prodigy Week part 1 and 2 at our first Prodigy DraftTM to fill a grid and the first racing series comprised of those who earned their way in. One cannot buy a drive in this series. We anticipate significant prize money for this professional series, with the goal of paying contracts to each driver, just like other professional sports leagues. And for those who excel on track within our IRL series, Racing Prodigy's goal is to have them move up to a second tier of a real-world racing series the following year, which would also be operated and controlled by Racing Prodigy. The end game is to have three levels of real racing, completing our e2RealTM league. For those with the skill, we want them to be able to make a career with us and not have to hunt for their own sponsors to stay in the sport.

This is why we have created the Prodigy Racing League - the world's first e2Real sports league. This league will be the first in motorsports with a real-world ladder, open to all, regardless of bank account size or connections.

For us to execute our plans, we will need interest and support from the sim racing community and participation via esports entries. We will provide both free-to-enter and pay-to-enter competitions (or a mix) to help fund the league. We have secured our first partners – Asetek SimSports®, SIM-LAB, and GRID Engineering – who share our passion to provide opportunities to those deserving and unlock the potential of motorsports. We may seek up to six team owners early in our league creation to partner with us, aiding us in offering these opportunities. We are launching an open coaching marketplace on RacingProdigy.com to generate more support for the racers and revenue to fund the league. We are not handpicking sim racers to offer their one-on-one coaching services, group coaching, data packs, track maps and more; we are creating an open marketplace and ecosystem that allows those with the skill and effort to participate and flourish. With these efforts and more, we work to greatly expand the sport we love.

The only way we accomplish this is together.





ESPORTS COMPETITION INFORMATION

Eligibility

- No purchase necessary to participate.
- To be eligible, you must:
 - Be a Street Kart Racing and Racing Prodigy member in good standing to compete in the competition.
 - Be at least 13 years old by the final day of qualifying to compete and can provide legal proof.
 - Have either a valid, unrestricted driver's license (learner's permit does not qualify) or a valid racing license from an accredited racing sanctioning body such as National Auto Sport Association, SportsCar Club of America, and others.
 - Please confirm with Racing Prodigy prior to entering, if uncertain, at support@RacingProdigy.com. NOTE: if you are tournament winner and are not of the legal age for a driver's license, we will make our best and most reasonable efforts to help you obtain a racing license.
- You are **ineligible** to compete in a Racing Prodigy competition if you:
 - Are currently a legal resident in North Korea, Cuba, Iran, Syria, Myanmar, Crimea, Sudan, or Alaska.
 - \circ Under 13 years old by the end of the Qualifying portion of the competition.
 - Have any professional racing experience in real life within sports car, stock car, or open wheel racing series such as, but not limited to: SRO, IMSA, IndyCar, Formula One, Formula 2, Formula 3, Indy Lights, Pro Mazda, USF2000, NASCAR Cup Series, Xfinity Series, NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series, and ARCA Menards Series. Exceptions are any sim-to-real scholarship winners (e.g., Nissan PlayStation GT Academy, World's Fastest Gamer) who have not competed in at least six (6) professional races dating back to January 1, 2022.
 - Are taller than 6'3" (190.5cm) in height and/or weigh more than 230 pounds (104kg) without driver gear or can't physically pilot the Radical SR1 race car without modifications to the car. These thresholds are to ensure driver safety in the Radical SR1.
 - Racing Prodigy, Inc. employees, advisors, contractors, and their immediate family members (including spouse, children, parents, siblings, and any other persons residing in the same household) are not eligible to participate in the tournament or claim any prizes. This exclusion applies to individuals who are employed or associated with the organizing committee, sponsors, or any other entity directly involved in the planning, execution, or promotion of the tournament. The intention behind this restriction is to ensure fairness and impartiality in the competition, avoiding any potential conflicts of interest or favoritism

How to Enter

- You must register on <u>RacingProdigy.com</u> prior to the end of Daily Qualifiers.
- Go to Street Kart Racing iOS app to compete. Download the game <u>here</u>.

Note: Only one entry is allowed per person and per Account.





Competition Structure, Process, and Timeline

- Dates & Times of the Daily Qualifiers (stage 1 of 4 of the competition):
 - The Daily Qualifiers are time trial events.
 - Daily Qualifiers begin Wednesday, September 20, 2023, at 19:00 (or 7:00 pm) Eastern Time (11:00 am GMT).
 - Daily Qualifiers end Saturday, October 7, 2023, at 18:59 (or 6:59 pm) Eastern Time (10:59 pm GMT).
- Advancing to the next stage: The top 20% of eligible racers each day, based on the total fastest time on any given 2-lap race run during each Daily Qualifier, will earn their opportunity to compete in the Main Event. These 20% will unlock a Racing Prodigy TKM kart that is usable for the Main Event. This kart will be ineligible for other SK competitions such as Weekly Championships.
 - Drivers have the option to qualify on any or all of the available Daily Qualifier tracks.
 - The Racing Prodigy TKM karts will be automatically unlocked to those who qualify, and will be found in the Daily Qualifier's in-game garage.
 - For those unable to advance, or wish to advance quicker from Daily Qualifiers to start practice sessions for the Main Event, the Main Event TKM karts (usable in all SK Racing Tournaments) will be available for purchase and will allow access to advance to the Main Event.
- Dates & Times of the Main Event: Heat (stage 2 of 4):
 - The Main Event: Heat is a time trial event.
 - Main Event: Heat begins Saturday, October 7, 2023, at 19:00 (or 7:00 pm) Eastern Time (11:00 pm GMT).
 - Main Event: Heat duration will be 48 hours.
 - Main Event: Heat ends Monday, October 9, 2023, at 19:59 (or 7:59 pm) Eastern Time (11:59 pm GMT).
- Advancing to the next stage: The top 50% of eligible racers, based on the total fastest time on any given 2-lap race during the Main Event: Heat, will earn their opportunity to compete in the Main Event: Pre-Finals.
- Main Event: Pre-Finals (stage 3 of 4):
 - The Main Event: Pre-Finals are time trial events.
 - Main Event: Pre-Finals begin Monday, October 9, 2023, at 20:00 (or 8:00 pm) Eastern Time (Tuesday, October 10 25, 2023, at 12:00 am GMT).
 - Main Event: Pre-Finals duration will be 48 hours.
 - Players will be split into two groups odd finishing positions from the Main Event: Heat will be placed into one group and even numbers into another group.
 - Main Event: Pre-Finals end Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 19:59 (or 7:59 pm) Eastern Time (11:59 pm GMT).
- Advancing to the next stage: The top 50% of eligible racers, based on the total fastest time on any given 3-lap race during the Main Event: Pre-Finals, will earn their opportunity to compete in the Main Event: Finals.
- Dates & Times of the Main Event: Finals (A & B Final stage 4 of 4):
 - The Main Event: Finals are time trial events.
 - Main Event: Finals begin Thursday, October 12, 2023, at 7:00 (or 7:00 am) Eastern Time (11:00 am GMT).
 - \circ Main Event: Finals duration will be 56 hours.





- Based on Pre-Finals performance, the top 50% of the fastest players (based on total fastest lap times per race), will be placed in the A Final to compete for the Prodigy Pass, top 10 prizes, and Aces (premium SK Racing in-game currency). Players who finish the Main Event: Pre-Finals in the bottom 50% of fastest times will be placed in the B Final to compete for Aces (premium SK Racing in-game currency).
- Main Event: Finals end on Saturday, October 14, 2023, at 3:00 (or 3:00 pm) Eastern Time (7:00 pm GMT).
- **Kart**: Players may use any Cadet kart in the Daily Qualifiers. The Main Event stages will use the Racing Prodigy TKM karts. Three Racing Prodigy TKM karts will be available to unlock or purchase and each will have their setup optimized for the track they are unlocked on: Fast / Tight / Balanced.
- **Track**: Stage 1 (Daily Qualifiers) will take place in-game using three tracks: Wackersdorf (Germany), Todd Road (Australia), and PF International (England). Each track will be used for one of the Main Event Stages and racers will not know in advance which will be used for each Stage: Main Event: Heat, Pre-Finals, and Finals.
- **Time Trials**: will take place in races with other AI/users on track. **Only the fasted total lap times during** each race matter for purposes of progression in this tournament.
 - Daily Qualifiers: 2-lap race at Wackersdorf, Todd Road, and PF International
 - Main Event: Heat: 2-lap race at 1 of the three Daily Qualifier tracks
 - Main Event: Pre-Finals: 3-lap race at 1 of the three Daily Qualifier tracks
 - Main Event: Finals: 4-lap race at 1 of the three Daily Qualifier tracks
- **Notifications**: iOS users with Push Notifications turned ON for Street Kart Racing will receive notifications on starting and ending times, standings, and more. Message and data rates may apply.

Daily Qualifier Details

- All drivers will be driving on the same track conditions per daily Race Meet. The weather will change daily but be the same throughout each event Race Meet.
- Any Cadet kart can be used for entry.
- Drivers may qualify on any, or all, of the three available tracks to advance to the Main Event. All tracks will be available to qualify on each day.
- Drivers will be able to unlock up to three different Racing Prodigy TKM karts by qualifying on each track. These TKM karts are available to use in the Main Event Stages and have their setups optimized for each track.
- Bonus tires (only for Racing Prodigy event(s) and not normal championships) can be earned during the Daily Qualifier event via Daily Log In Bonus. Players will get a free set of Racing Prodigy Tires just for logging in daily and going to Race Prep.
- Additional Racing Prodigy Tire Packs will be available for purchase.
- Spare Racing Prodigy Tires (from purchase) will be usable for any potential future Racing Prodigy SK Racing tournaments.
- Tires for the entire event will be the Racing Prodigy tires only. These have been designed specifically for the competition. Other tire brands will not be allowed.
- Tire, Kart, and Engine wear will be set to ON.
- Fuel will be consumed.
- You are not limited to the number of 2-lap runs you turn in on tracks during Daily Qualifier sessions.





- The fastest times will be dynamically ranked in the leaderboards and will change dynamically as new times are created.
- iOS users with Push Notifications turned ON for Street Kart Racing will receive notifications on position changes. Message and data rates may apply.

Race Pass 30 Day Free Trial Details

To enter the Main Event: Heats, all drivers must have the SK Racing subscription service, Race Pass. This will be offered as a 30-day free trial to all new players and those that have never had Race Pass before. It is worth \$4.99 and has been made free exclusively for this competition.

Race Pass will cost \$4.99 (or your country App Store equivalent price) on a monthly on-going basis after the 30day free trial. This supports the developers and continued work on the game.

Race Pass can be cancelled at any time with no on-going commitment. With the 30-day free trial the competition can be entered without cost.

Race Pass is required for the Main Event: Heat, Pre-Finals, and Finals.

Main Event: Heat, Pre-Finals, and Finals Details

- All drivers will be driving on the same track conditions, which will not change throughout the session.
- The Racing Prodigy TKM karts will be used for the Main Event: Heat, Pre-Finals, and Finals.
- Tire wear will be set to ON. Drivers will receive one set of Racing Prodigy Tires (Soft) and one set of Racing Prodigy Tires (Mediums) per stage. Additional Racing Prodigy Tire Packs will be available for purchase.
- Tires will be the Racing Prodigy tires only. These have been designed specifically for the competition. Other tire brands will not be allowed.
- Fuel will be consumed.
- You are not limited in the number of runs you turn in during Main Event: Heat, Pre-Finals, or Finals.
- The fastest times will be dynamically ranked in the leaderboards and will change dynamically as new times are created.
- iOS users with Push Notifications turned ON for Street Kart Racing will receive notifications on position changes. Message and data rates may apply.

Additional Rules and Requirements of the Competition (Racing)

THE PRIZES AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR REAL-WORLD RACING

Prodigy Passes to Prodigy Week. Two Paths.

Recipients of a Prodigy Pass will be eligible to compete at Prodigy Week, part 1, at Atlanta Motorsports Park in a Radical SR1, October 30 – November 1, 2023.

The official winner of the A Final on October 14 will be awarded the twelfth Prodigy Pass, which includes free air travel to and from Atlanta Hartsfield International Airport, transport, food, and lodging in Georgia, United States. Full details will be provided upon request.

In addition to winning a PRL esports competition, Racing Prodigy members (RPMs) who register have an additional opportunity to earn a Prodigy Pass through the Prodigy Search; how it works:

- Those who register for this tournament are eligible. You will receive instructions for submission upon tournament registration at RacingProdigy.com.
- Those eligible may record responses to questions and submit a video (60-seconds in length is the maximum), respond in writing to a questionnaire, and submit a headshot photo for marketing and social media promotion. The submissions (video, questionnaire, and photo) are due on the 7th of October by 1:00 pm EDT.
- Racing Prodigy will review the submissions to select up to 10 finalists from this PRL esports competition.
- Racing Prodigy will submit these videos to the Prodigy Search Committee. The Committee will review other tournament finalists and select at least one (1) recipient for a Prodigy Pass, announced on Racing Prodigy's <u>YouTube channel</u> on October 12 at 1:00 pm Eastern.
- Details about the Prodigy Search Committee program and process can be found in writing <u>here</u> and video <u>here</u>.

This is a collective effort to better ensure a prodigy may not slip by simply by not yet being the fastest in these sim racing competitions and further open motorsports.

The top performers in the Main Event (Heat, Pre-Finals, A & B Finals) will be awarded Aces (premium SK Racing in-game currency) based on overall finishing position in each stage. See the Race Pass leaderboard in-game for more details.

Main Event: A Final participants will all receive the premium Racing Prodigy TKM Kart Unlocks worth \$17.97 on the App Store which can be used in all TKM championship events over the next 12 months.

SK Racing players can participate in league play across multiple potential Racing Prodigy SK Racing tournaments. Position ranking will be tracked for the top players from the A Final and B Final in this PRL SK Racing TKM Continental Cup, the previous X30 Miami Cup tournament, and from future potential SK Racing PRL Tournaments. The top 48 non-Prodigy Pass finalists will be eligible for a chance to compete to win a PC & sim-rig equipped with products from official partners of Racing Prodigy and the Prodigy Racing League, <u>Asetek</u> <u>SimSports®</u>, <u>Sim-Lab</u>, and <u>GRID Engineering</u>. This prize will be awarded to the winner at the end of 2023.
